
Spring term 2106 Happy New Year and welcome back!

We work closely with our Education Welfare Officer, Naina Zavery who deals with matters of absence and lateness in this school. The government's minimum expectation for attendance is 96.5%. We are very pleased to report that our attendance exceeds this target.

From September attendance has been 97.72% which is excellent and 43% of all our pupils have 100% attendance which is impressive. Thank you for your support and keep up the good work!

Safeguarding Our Children

All Leicestershire Schools have become part of a new safeguarding initiative, which aims to improve outcomes for

children and families affected by domestic violence and abuse.





Uniform

We are proud of our school uniform and like all children to wear it.
Uniform is available from the office as are Sew on Uniform badges are available free of charge from the school office

This scheme has been designed to provide early reporting to schools of any domestic abuse incidents that might have an impact on a child that attends their school. The scheme is called **Operation Encompass** and is run in partnership with Leicestershire County Council and Leicestershire Police.

To further support the welfare of children during the school term Mrs de Looze or Mrs Scott will be informed when any domestic abuse incident has been reported to the police and one of our pupils was in the household. The information will remain confidential and only shared on a strictly need-to-know basis, for example with the class teacher. It will not be shared with any pupils.
