Tilly the Tortoise



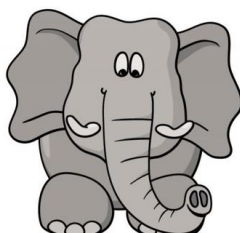
Think up new ideas and questions
