

As writers...

In our writing lessons, we'll explore the theme of friendship in our stories Yeti and the Bird and Julian is a mermaid. We'll create our own narrative, focusing on writing in the third person using adverbs and the past tense to enhance our descriptions. We'll also learn to add suffixes to words and practice writing complete sentences that start with capital letters and end with full stops. We will also be looking at poetry structures and having a go at writing own poems.

As unique individuals...

We will be thinking about Economic wellbeing. We will discuss how to look after money and learn about saving money and spending it responsibly. What is the role of banks and building societies?

As musicians...

We are going to be developing our understanding of technology structure and form. We will be using this to help us create a series of short compositions which we will perform to each other.

As designers...

In our Art curriculum, students explore maps through looking at relief maps, abstract maps. We will make our own creative journey maps and look at how to print and display it.

As scientists...

We will be investigating Animals including humans and their life cycles. We will explore the life cycles of a chicken, butterfly and frog. We will look at our own lives from baby to adulthood and old age.
