

# Squirrels Summer 1 - Curriculum Plan

## English

We will be writing a narrative sequel inspired by the story 'The Ever Changing World.'

Then we are going to look at the story Flotsam, which is a wonderful picture book that I'm sure will inspire great writing.



## Maths

In Squirrels, we continue to focus on fractions throughout the summer term. Even looking at adding and subtracting them.

Later in the term we will move on to capacity and measure.



## RE

Our RE Topic is titled 'What kind of world did Jesus want?' The children will focus on the stories of Noah and Abraham to inspire their thinking and reflections.



## Science

We are focusing on Animals, including humans. Looking specifically the way we classify them in to different animal kingdoms and species.



## Geography

In Geography, we will be focusing on the topic of rainforests. We will look at the climates, animals and settlements we might find there. The children will also do some field work in our local area.



## Computing

We will be focusing on using Scratch as a programming tool. The children will cover making games, short movies and debugging broken algorithms



## Art

As artists the children will be covering techniques such as carving, modelling, and creating 3D structures from 2D materials, usually culminating in a free-standing, recycled sculpture.



## Music

We will be focusing on 20th Century music with a focus on appreciation for different musical styles and their features.



## PSHE

With Mrs. Ghirardelli, we will learn how to look after our money and be understanding of economic issues. We will think about saving money for our futures.



## French
