English

In English, we will be using the book *The Odyssey* by Gillian Cross to write our own epic story.

We will then move on to 'The Arrival' by Shaun Tan where they will do a narrative retelling.



RE

Our RE Topic is titled 'Why is the Torah so important to Jewish people?' - This aims to explain why the Torah is so important to Jewish people.



Art

As artists, we will be doing observational drawing, monoprinting, and studying the structural and artistic styles of Zaha Hadid and Friedensreich Hundertwasser.



Science

We are focusing on properties of materials. This unit looks at how to compare and group together everyday materials based on their properties.



Music

We will be moving on to looking at voice. We will look at vocal control, exploring different sounds, ensemble singing and active listening.



Maths

We will start the year by looking at Place Value and the four operations.

We will focus on formal written methods and deepening our understanding of number.



Geography

In Geography, we will be focusing on why our population changes. It will look at migration and the effect this can have on our climate.



PSHE

Children will learn about friendships, family relationships, self-respect, and marriage. They will also explore bullying, stereotypes, discrimination, and how to seek help when needed.



Computing

We will be looking at the Mars Rover. It uses a space exploration theme where students learn about computing architecture, the fetch-decode-execute cycle, and binary code.



French

This unit teaches how to say and write the date. This unit helps students master numbers, days of the week, and months of the year in their target language.
