Castles Fit For a Queen

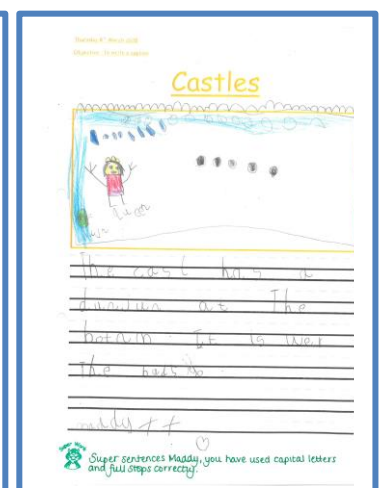
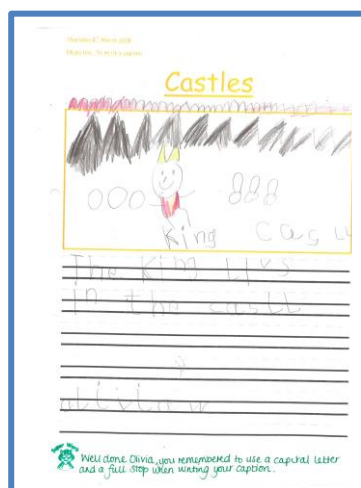
What a fantastic morning the Tigers and their adult helpers have had this morning at the Stay and Play castle building workshop.
