English

In English, we will be writing real life stories based on the celebration of Mardi Gras. Our grammar focus will be verb types and writing speech which will enhance our writing all around.

Then we will be looking at a recount of the life of choreographer Matthew Bourne and focusing on the present perfect tense in grammar.

<u>Science</u>

In science, we will identify appliances that use electricity in our homes and how to keep safe around electricity.

We will also will construct circuits, start to create pictorial circuits and conduct investigations.

Art and Design

We will be looking at prehistoric art and cave paintings. This will help improve our drawing and to appreciate the artistic skill that has been present throughout time.

Stone Age to Iron Age

<u>PSHE</u>

In PSHE, we will be thinking about economic wellbeing and how to look after money. As a class we will think about budgeting, spending and jobs.

Religious Education

In RE, we will focus on the Pentecost story and how it has impacted the Christian religion. The class will make a Pentecost banner and will discuss the symbolism.

Maths

In Maths this term, we will be focusing on Decimals in Year 4 whilst the Year 3's will start a new topic of measurement. They will be focusing on mass and capacity.

Then later in the term we will be looking at statistics and geometry. Whilst going through the curriculum we will spend time re-capping anything that we feel that the children need reminding of.

History

In history we will be looking at the time periods Stone Age to Iron Age.

<u>French</u>
