with enjoyment and have a steady sense of fun.

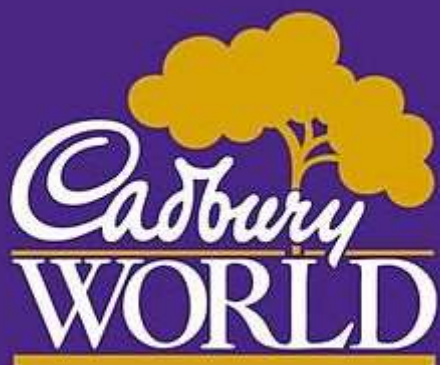
