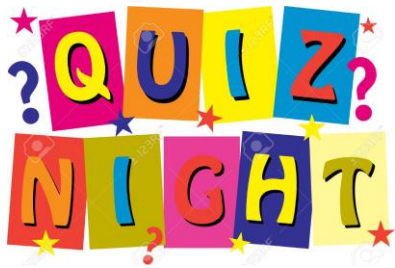
Chick news:
