"Thank you. I loved all of the activities."

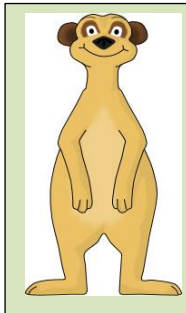
"On the climbing frame I reached the top twice and loved going fast on the zip wire."
