





Rocket Words

season	one of 4 parts of the year; spring, summer, autumn and winter
spring	a season between March and May
summer	a season between June and August
autumn	a season between September and November
winter	a season between December and February
hibernate	to sleep through the winter
temperature	how warm or cool something is
weather	the conditions and temperature outside
change	to become different
heatwave	high temperatures for several days
results	the outcome of an experiment
measuring	recording how much of something there is
