

AS WRITERS... We will become journalists by writing our own newspaper articles about a well-known fairy tale. We will be learning about a significant event in history (moon landing of 1969) and investigate how the event could be written from different viewpoints

We will continue to use our writing across other areas of the curriculum through writing formal letters or recounts.

AS GEOGRAPHERS...

We will be continuing to look at the big question

Who are Britain's National Parks for?

AS HISTORIANS... The story of The Trojan Horse: historical fact, legend, or classical myth? This investigation invites the learner to explore the causes and consequences of this 10-year war and to evaluate the conflicting evidence relating to the famous story of the so-called Trojan Horse,

AS SCIENTISTS...

We will be looking at how we can Look After Our Environment. We will learn all about sustainability and children explore: the core concepts - 'so what the climate is, how it changes, the difference between a man-made and natural environment and where different types of animals live'.

This leads on from previous learning in Lower Key Stage Two on the environment.

AS MATHEMATICIANS...

A continuous thread for both year groups will be applying their knowledge, especially times tables, to reasoning problems.

We will be using our knowledge of the four operations and place value to extend our Mathematical Thinking by studying decimals, fractions and percentages.

IN PHSE...

We will be looking at Citizenship. They will understand how to look after the environment and the laws of the UK. They will learn about their part in society.

IN ICT...

AS LINGUISTS....
