



## **Belton Update 14<sup>th</sup> September 2020**

A slightly late update this week but as you can imagine it has been an extremely busy week. The children are continuing to get back into school life and we are really pleased with how they continue to settle back in.

### **Face masks for adults on school property.**

As you will know I haven't asked parents or those dropping off or picking up the children to wear face masks in the playground. However, with the growing number of schools being affected by Covid-19, from tomorrow, I would ask anyone over the age of 12, unless medically exempt to wear a face mask when coming on to school grounds. This has been a difficult decision but safety is paramount. This does not include school staff.

### **Drop off and pick up**

Please, if you are picking up more than one child please wait on the bottom playground. You may also have noticed white spots on the playground floor. These measure 2 metres apart and are for adults to stand on whilst waiting to be socially distanced. Drop off and pick up is considered to be a pinch point in the day so please follow these measures. Please leave promptly after drop off and pick up.

### **Parking**

**Please be careful how and where you park at drop off and pick up. The PAVEMENT area near the car park gate is not the best place to park. It is really difficult for people to see round the corner if cars are coming and I have already had complaints about safety. Also I have had local residents complaining about people parking across their driveways. The community police have been informed.**

Please can your child bring a donation of a non-perishable item on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September to school. The donations will be for the foodbank. It needs to be something they are able to carry up to church themselves. Vicar Louise will lead an act of worship for each bubble during the day (with a clean in between) in church. No parents will be allowed but each class will be sharing something they have done in class during each individual session. We are going to try to put a little video together to share with you.

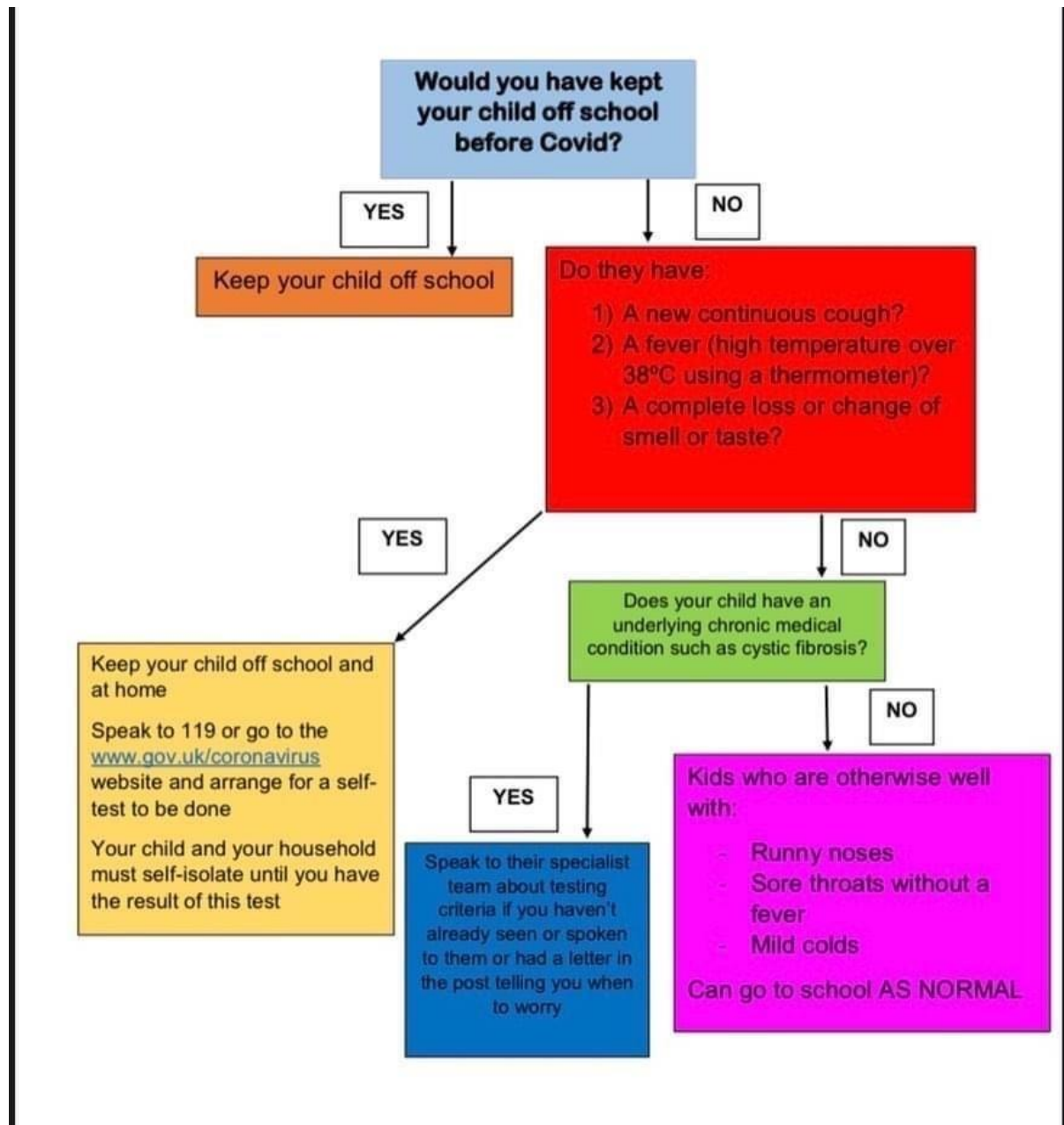
### **Google Classroom**
