





#### Feedback








The school has high expectations for my child.







The school supports my child's wider personal development.




Does your child have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND)? 26 responses




My child has SEND, and the school gives them the support they need to succeed. 3 responses



The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year. 26 responses


