WEDUC

There had been some parents who have not been receiving Notifications from Weduc. Here are some instructions for a Samsung user to be able to turn the Notifications back on:

The first thing to remember is to make sure you check that Notifications for the app are turned on, if they are then please follow the following steps.



1. Go to Settings.
2. Click on Apps.
3. Next, select the Weduc app
4. After that, select Battery then 'Optimise Battery Usage'
5. There is a drop down at the top that should say 'Apps Not optimised' select this drop down then select 'All'
6. Again, scroll through the menu until you get to the Weduc App
7. The slider on the right hand side should be Blue, select it so that it goes Grey and this should allow Notifications to come through.

It is really important to remember that each Android phone will have a different wording for each step, however the steps are relatively similar. These steps given to you are directly from a Samsung device so should hopefully work for all Samsung users.
