- Gaining control over fastenings when getting dressed and undressed for P.E sessions
- Gaining better control when holding a pencil
- Using and holding scissors correctly

- Talk about likes and dislikes
- Talk about family customs and routines
- Explore the seasons
- Learn about Harvest
- Find out about hibernation around the world
- Use a simple paint programme on the computer



# **Mathematics**

- Counting 0- 5 forwards and backwards
- Using number names 0-5 in order in familiar contexts
- Counting reliably up to 5 objects and match to correct numeral.
- Finding 1 more or less than a given number (0-5).
- Using mathematical language to describe 2D shapes
- Match shapes by recognising similarities.
- Sorting objects bases on attributes such as colour, size or shape

- Making friends, sharing, taking turns and manners.
- Learning the rules of the classroom
