Google Meet Rule Reminders:

- Being online for registration in the morning and afternoon and any online meets is expected. Please make sure that your child is logging on at these times, it is taking the office a lot of time to ring those who haven't registered. Permission for absence from any google meet needs to be granted by me, thank you to those who have already spoken to me and let me know reasons why etc. This is part of our commitment to safeguarding
- No eating on a google meet
- Wear appropriate clothes (including the other people in the house who might end up walking past the camera!)
- Children at home need to be in a communal area not in their bedroom please
- No mobile phones to be used during google meets
- No screen shots taken (this will result in suspension of the account)

Small things just to help us out

- When sending a photo please just send one when you send lots the teacher has to look at through them all. Please send them the right way up if you can!
- Please send work through Google Classroom
- Please don't give the children too much help! We need to know what they can do on their own!
- If you are struggling, need help, resources or a friendly ear please give us a ring. We know this is really tough and we are only too happy to help

Covid Winter Support Grant

Covid Winter Support Grant | Leicestershire County Council

The Covid Winter Support Grant (CWSG) has been provided by the Government to local authorities to support families (with or without children) or individuals.

Those who are struggling financially over the winter period with:

- food
- energy costs over the winter

The fund runs from 1 December 2020 until 31 March 2021.

What additional support is available:

- Food vouchers
- Fuel vouchers towards prepayment meter credit, redeemable cash vouchers to pay off energy arrears, or heating fuel purchases.
- Heaters
- Heated seats

Who may be eligible for additional support?

Those who may be eligible might include:

- Families with vulnerable children aged 0-5 or that may not qualify for FSM that are known to social workers and Children and Family Wellbeing Service but are not accessing Free Early Education Entitlement. (FEEE)
- A family with or without children who are experiencing financial hardship due to Covid, which means that they are struggling to feed their family, to heat their home, or with other household costs etc.
- Gypsy and the travelling community

Please get in contact with Miss Scott if you are eligible as referrals can only be made through school.
