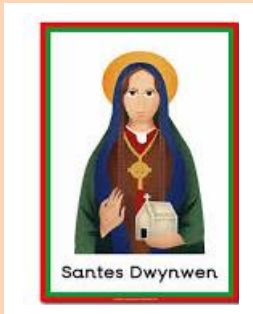


School News
